If you do not provide the information required on the form then we will not be able to process your application.

The Board will share your information with Lindsey Marsh Drainage Board in line with our data sharing agreement.

Your data may also be shared with Board Members, the Environment Agency, Lead Local Flood Authority, local district councils and agents/representatives acting on our behalf. Data may be used in order to prevent or detect crime, to protect public funds or where we are required or permitted to share data under other legislation.

Your personal data will be kept for a period of 10 years in paper and electronic format in line with our document retention policy.

You have the right to access your data and to ask us to rectify mistakes. In some circumstances you may also have the right to request we erase your data, restrict our processing, object to processing or move your data.
